New head quarter: HGHI Holding GmbH moved into the historical Mendelssohn-Palais in Berlin-Mitte

Berlin, September 27th, 2017. The impressive Mendelssohn-Palais is the new Headquarter of the HGHI Holding GmbH.

Besides numerous historical rooms the two-storied Mendelssohn-Palais has a variety of modern offices. On the 1,400 sqm terrain the total floor area amounts to 5,200 sqm.

Next to the incomparable and unique charme of the historical building, the Mendelssohn-Palais with its high-quality substance and an interaction between tradition and modernity is the perfect room for an inspiring working atmosphere.
